

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ACCORDING TO HOUSEHOLD INCOMES

R0,00 - R122 000pa

This category is reserved for students that are totally unfunded.

Criteria

1st years :

Must be from quintile 1 -3 school / Sassa dependant

Family/ Household gross income < R122 000 pa

Must be registered for fulltime 1st undergraduate qualification

Senior students

Must be from quintile 1 -3 school

Family/ Household gross income < R122 000 pa / Sassa dependant

Must be admitted for fulltime studies

Must meet n+2 criteria, i.e. passed sufficient number of modules/subjects to enable them to complete their studies in the minimum number of years of study plus 2 years

Concessions that will apply

No down payment for tuition and/or accommodation is required

May register for on-campus as well as off campus accredited accommodation, space permitting

Outstanding debt may be carried forward

Will receive allowances for books, and depending on accommodation situation, may receive meals or transport allowance

R122 001 - R350 000pa

This is the new DHET bursary scheme category and is reserved for FTEN students. A FTEN student is a person that has never before been registered at any university and is entering the university at an undergraduate level for the 1st time and for their 1st undergraduate qualification.

Criteria

Must not have registered at any university before

Must be accepted for 1st undergraduate qualification for the 1st time

Family/ Household gross income < R350 000 pa

SA citizen

Concessions that will apply

No down payment for tuition and/or accommodation is required

May register for on-campus as well as off campus accredited accommodation, space permitting

Will receive allowances for books, and depending on accommodation situation, may receive meals or transport allowance

R0,00 - < R600 000
Students in this category will receive a 8% grant in respect of tuition and official accommodation fees.
Criteria
Family/ Household gross income < R600 000 pa
Only SA citizens
Not in receipt of other bursaries/scholarships/sponsorships that cover full tuition and accommodation
Concessions that will apply
Students will receive a credit adjustment in respect of tuition and official accommodation fees.
Bursaries/sponsorships received after the initial credit adjustment will require re-calculation of the credit adjustment
