

ADDITIONAL STUDENTS

The NSF wishes to increase the number of students that it supported for the 2025 academic year by awarding 600 bursaries to deserving recipients.

This process will commence on 26 January 2026 and close on 6 February 2026 with the following parameters

FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

- a) Students pursuing qualifications linked to Scarce and critical skills, Occupations in High Demand and High-end Skills, STEM qualification.
- b) No less than 65% academic achievement overall.
- c) Selected students could be 1st or 2nd, or 3rd level of study.
- d) Students who did not qualify for the NSFAS funding.
- e) Income threshold from R0.00 to less than R600 000.00 per annum combined.
- f) Student must have been registered in 2025 and continuing in 2026.



SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

Ensure all documentation is complete and accurate to avoid delays in processing.

- ✓ R0.00 to R600 000 combined household with:
- ✓ Declarations of income
- ✓ Proof of employment / Proof of income for both parents/guardians
- ✓ Fully completed and signed application form
