The Compensation Fund invites qualifying Young Persons who wish to study for an undergraduate or selected post-graduate programme to apply for the COID Bursary.

Unemployed people who acquired a permanent disablement due to occupational injuries/ diseases (COID Pensioners), **Not in Employment, Education, and Training (NEET)**, the dependants of COID Pensioners and the Dependants of Fatally injured workers are encouraged to apply.

The bursary covers: • Tuition fees, Book Allowance, Monthly Leaving Allowance and Accommodation (Institution accredited) in alignment with NSFAS/DHET Guidelines. • The award is renewable every year – for the duration of the study programme enrolled – depending on the availability of funds and outstanding academic performance of successful applicants.

Eligibility requirements:

- Unemployed South African Citizen
- Annual Combined household income bracket of R600 000 and below (Missing middle)
- Academically deserving students
- Students registered for specified applicable qualifications

How to apply for this bursary opportunity:

- Students to obtain an application form via the Financial aid office
- Students are to submit a completed application form accompanied by the previous year's results, certified copies of identity documents and supporting documents as indicated in the application form.
- Applications are to be submitted to the financial aid office on or before **Tuesday, 02 March 2023**
